## Testing and Sharpening the skills of your ROTC Students

Cyber criminals are not resting up during COVID-19. Keeping skills sharp and people focused on problem solving is crucial. Are you looking for an original and challenging way to keep your ROTC Students engaged whilst they wait for the new semester? Do you need a good exercise to help keep their cybersecurity skills on par?

SANS has developed the SANS Mixed Disciplines CTF to do just that. Each Senior Military College (SMC) is allotted up to 15 participants for a total of 90 participants across all six SMCs.

The CTF offers 50 challenges in Cyber Defense, PenTesting, Incident Response, Threat Hunting, Digital Forensics and Threat Intelligence. It can be played remotely on the Internet without special requirements.

On completion of the event you will be sent the results of your team's performance which shows who scored best in the different disciplines.
